ELECTRONIC DEATH REGISTRY/BURIAL PERMITS


- ALL DOCUMENTS ARE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY SINCE JANUARY 2016
- ALL DEATH CERTIFICATES ARE OBTAINED VIA THE NEVADA DIVISION OF PUBLIC AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH – OFFICE OF VITAL STATISTICS
- THE NYE COUNTY HEALTH OFFICER CURRENTLY HAS NO RESPONSIBILITY RELATED TO THE DEATH REGISTRY AND BURIAL PERMITS

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT APRIL – JUNE 2018

- PROVIDED 8 CLINICS IN 3 NYE COMMUNITIES (TONOPAH, BEATTY, PAHRUMP) AND GOLDFIELD IN ESMERALDA COUNTY.
- 183 PARTICIPANTS – ALL AGES PROVIDED WITH SERVICES
- COLLABORATION IN ALL COMMUNITIES
- OUTREACH WAS EFFECTIVE
- GREAT COOPERATION
- TOTAL COST FOR 11 CLINICS (6 NYE, 2 GOLDFIELD, 3 WHITE PINE/CLARK)
\$51,530



MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT DENTAL

- 117 PARTICIPANTS
 - ALL COMPLETED ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENTS
 - SERVICES INCLUDED:
 - *108 FLUORIDE VARNISH APPLICATIONS
 - *212 SEALANTS
 - *16 COMPLETE CLEANINGS
- 

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT IMMUNIZATION SERVICES

- 66 PARTICIPANTS
- ABLE TO OFFER VACCINATIONS TO PRIVATELY AND PUBLICLY INSURED, AS WELL AS, THE UNINSURED.
- A TOTAL OF 146 VACCINATIONS WERE GIVEN INCLUDING:
 - *TDAP (44)
 - *SHINGLES (42)

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT OTHER SERVICES PROVIDED

- VISION SCREENINGS – BEATTY, GOLDFIELD AND TONOPAH
 - *20 SCREENED – NO REFERRALS
- BLOOD SUGAR SCREENINGS IN BEATTY
 - *15 SCREENINGS
 - *SEVERAL REFERRALS TO PCP FOR FOLLOW UP
- BLOOD PRESSURE SCREENINGS IN BEATTY, TONOPAH AND GOLDFIELD

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT PARTICIPANT FEEDBACK

- MANY PARTICIPANTS DO HAVE A PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER: 43% (APRIL); 61.5% (JUNE)
- DENTAL ACCESS AND CARE ARE SIGNIFICANT NEEDS IN RURAL COMMUNITIES
 - *1 IN 4 HAD SEEN A DENTIST WITHIN THE PAST 6 MONTHS
 - *ONE THIRD REPORTED IT HAD BEEN MORE THAN 5 YEARS SINCE SEEING A DENTIST
- MORE THAN HALF OF PARTICIPANTS IN TONOPAH, GOLDFIELD AND BEATTY TRAVEL GREATER THAN 100 MILES FOR HEALTHCARE ACCESS

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT PARTICIPANT FEEDBACK

- ALL COMMUNITIES CONTINUE TO HAVE UNINSURED. RATIO IS 3:1
- ALL COMMUNITIES REPORTED HAVING CITIZENS THAT HAD SKIPPED OR MISSED A MEAL IN THE PAST 30 DAYS DUE TO LACK OF ACCESS AND/OR MONEY. DURING APRIL EVENTS NO ONE REPORTED SKIPPING MEALS. IN JUNE, 8% OF EVENT PARTICIPANTS REPORTED MISSING MEALS
 - *ONE COMMENTED ON USING FOOD BANKS TO AVOID SKIPPING MEALS
 - *ONE PARTICIPANTS EATS 4 OUT OF 7 DAYS DUE TO LACK OF RESOURCES

MOBILE DENTAL VAN PILOT PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ABLE TO PROVIDE FOLLOW UP CARE FROM APRIL TO JUNE. TEETH CLEANING IN BEATTY, TONOPAH AND PAHRUMP
- ABLE TO PROVIDE IMMUNIZATION ACCESS TO BOTH PRIVATELY/PUBLICLY INSURED AND THOSE WITHOUT INSURANCE
- PROJECT VALIDATED THE NEED FOR ONGOING SERVICES – TOTAL OF 183 CLIENTS PARTICIPATED IN THE PROJECT.
- WORK GROUP INTEREST IN CONTINUING THE PROJECT. ONGOING FUNDING NEEDED.

CROSS JURISDICTIONAL SHARING GRANT UPDATE

- COLLABORATION WITH SOUTHERN NEVADA HEALTH DISTRICT
- AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO IN APRIL 2018
- IN-KIND PARTICIPATION ONLY; ARRANGE MEETINGS, IDENTIFY AND ENGAGE STAKEHOLDERS, PROVIDE FEEDBACK
- GRANT PROCESS HAS NOT BEEN INITIATED
- GRANT ENDS SEPTEMBER 2018

PERTUSSIS UPDATE

- FIRST NOTED INCREASED ACTIVITY IN NORTHERN NYE COUNTY IN SEPTEMBER – NOVEMBER 2017. 28 CASES
- CURRENT ACTIVITY IN PAHRUMP. TOTAL OF 19 CASES AS OF 6/25/2018. AGES RANGE FROM 2 MONTHS TO 62 YEARS OLD. HALF ARE ADULTS
- VACCINATION RATES ADULT POPULATION 18 – 30% DEPENDING ON ZIP CODE
